


OPEN ACCESS PUBLICATION

Many roads towards a single goal





The gold road consists in publishing research results in an Open Access journal or book.


Access to the document is immediate and free for all on the publisher's website. Publication fees (APC/BPC) may be charged to the author.

Fully Open Access journals are referenced in DOAJ.



Following the **green road**, authors deposit a freely accessible copy of their contribution in an **institutional archive** (such as the Archive ouverte UNIGE) or a **disciplinary archive** (arXiv, PMC, etc.)

In most cases, **Sherpa Romeo** lets authors determine whether a journal publisher requires an embargo and/or imposes restrictions on the version of the article they can share.





The **hybrid model** consists in publishing in a subscription journal and paying additional charges for the article to become available in OA. This is also possible for book chapters.

The risk with this model is that the publisher collects a **double payment**, unless a **Read&Publish** agreement was signed with the institution.
