

**18.03.2024 – The Revolution in Motion: Filming in the Revolutionary Period, Sérgio Dias Branco,
Universidade de Coimbra**

This lecture offers an overview of film production in Portugal throughout the revolutionary period of two years, that is, between April 25th of 1974 (the date of the coup organized by the Armed Forces Movement and popular uprising) and April 25th of 1976 (the date of the entry into force of the new Constitution of the Portuguese Republic). My focus will be on the films, filmmakers, and groups or organizations that tried to engage with the ongoing political and social transformation of the country, whose art practices must be contextualized.

Sérgio Dias Branco est Professeur adjoint d'études cinématographiques à l'Université de Coimbra, où il dirige le Master en Études Artistiques et coordonne le LIPA - Laboratoire d'investigation et pratiques artistiques. Il est chercheur au CEIS20 - Centre d'études interdisciplinaires de l'Université de Coimbra et collabore avec le Centre de Recherche en Théologie et Études Religieuses de l'Université Catholique Portugaise et Nova Institut de Philosophie à Lisbonne.
