

*Vocal expression features that differentiate 24 US English vs. Russian emotion words*



Note. Upper part of the square: US English emotion words, lower part of the square: Russian emotion words; marks a higher value than the other language, marks a lower value, (shadowed square) marks the cases when confidence intervals of the means do not overlap); LV-spoke louder, QV-spoke more quietly, TV-spoke in a trembling voice; AV-assertive voice; FS-fell silent; SU-produced a short utterance; LU-produced a long utterance, CM-changed the melody of speech; SD-had speech disturbances, SF-spoke faster, SS-spoke slower, NC-no vocal change.
