Barbara Wieland is a veterinarian from Switzerland with specialization in veterinary epidemiology, surveillance, risk analysis and international development. After a PhD in molecular epidemiology of zoonoses at the University of Bern, she worked as a post-doc on African swine fever virus at the Pirbright Institute and the Royal Veterinary College in the United Kingdom. From 2006 to 2012 she was a Lecturer in Veterinary Epidemiology the Royal Veterinary College and coordinated graduate and post-graduate programs and headed research on disease surveillance, herd health and risk analysis. She then managed the animal health programme of the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation in Mongolia. In 2015, she joined the International Livestock Research Institute in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, as principal scientist and developed and coordinated several research programmes on animal disease control and One Health in East and West Africa, as well as in Southeast Asia. In May 2021, she was appointed Director of the Institute of Virology and Immunology IVI in Switzerland.
