Matthias Egger MD, studied epidemiology at the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine. An infectious disease epidemiologist, his research interests include HIV/Aids, Ebola and tuberculosis, and COVID-19. Egger helps run the NIH-funded International epidemiology Database to Evaluate AIDS (IeDEA) of several people living with HIV globally. Methodological work on meta-analysis and health research quality and transparency has been another focus. Egger is a Professor of Epidemiology and Public Health at the universities of Bern, Switzerland, Bristol, UK and Cape Town, South Africa. Since 2017, he has been the President of the Swiss National Science Foundation’s research council. In 2020 he helped set up the Swiss National COVID-19 Science Task Force and served as its first chair.
