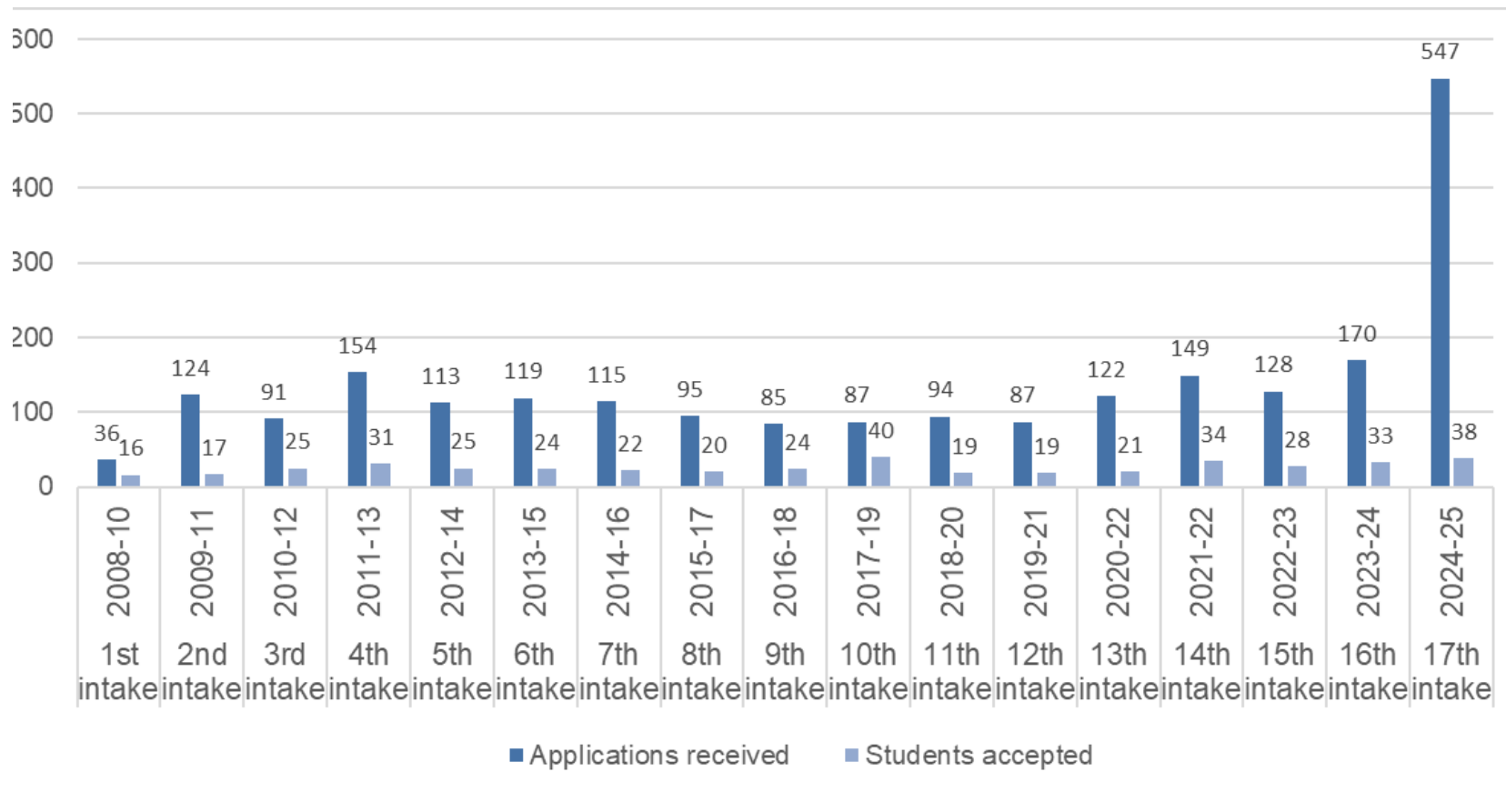

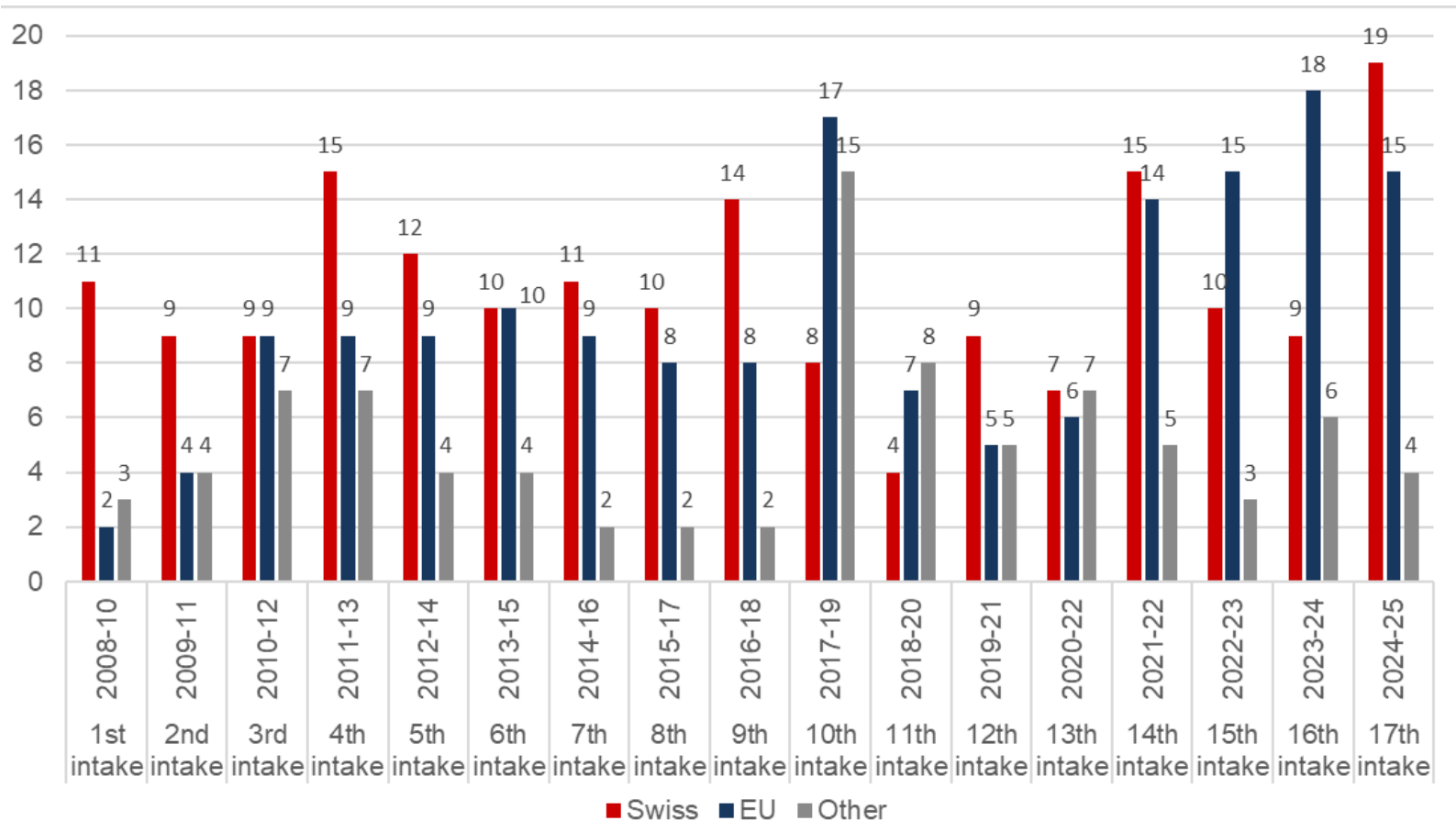

STUDENT'S NATIONALITIES

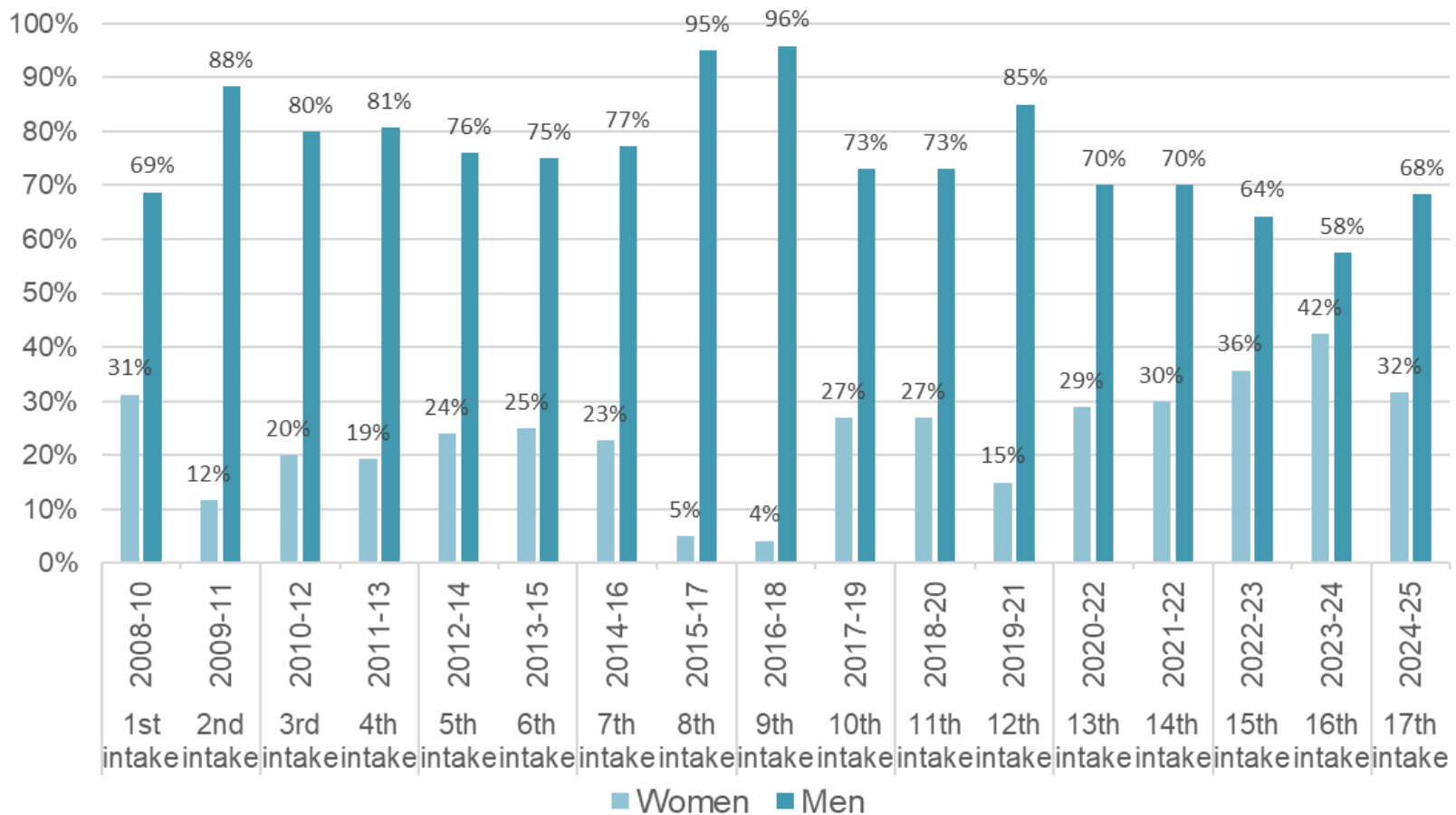

Cheating & Plagiarism

Academic dishonesty will be dealt with severity and can lead to expulsion and can take the following form:

Plagiarism and/or attempt at plagiarism is defined as:

- **inclusion of copied material** (whether word by word or close paraphrasing) from published documents without the use of quotation marks to signal such passages or an acknowledgment of their source;
- presenting conceptual ideas or models as one's own when they are in fact someone else's work;
- **using arguments taken from published sources without citing them** in the text or including the references in the bibliography (including web searches!).

Cheating and/or attempt to cheat in an exam violates the same principle as plagiarism and may include the following:

- **copying the work of other participants** in the exam room, or outside it in the case of individual assignments to be completed outside of class;
- **communication between participants during the exam**, unless this is explicitly authorized; and
- **bringing unauthorized materials inside the exam room**, unless this is explicitly authorized, even if the material in question is not used.



AI

Participants can use generative AI tools for developing their group presentation and/or individual assignment.

UNIGE provides students with access to Microsoft Copilot (via their University login, details will be provided in class). Students also have free access to a free version of ChatGPT and Google Gemini (and possibly other tools such as Claude).

When using AI for your work, please add a maximum half-page declaration with the following information:

- (1) Identify the AI tool(s) you used for your work
- (2) Describe how you used these tools by disclosing the parts of your work that were developed in collaboration with AI and identifying AI's contribution to these parts
- (3) Explain your unique contribution above and beyond outputs provided by AI.

Rules and conditions of success

- 51 ECTS spread over the 2 semesters courses
- Thesis 15 ECTS = 3rd semester
- Traineeship report 24 ECTS = 2nd semester
- A total of 90 ECTS is required to complete this Master

Master must be completed in maximum of 5 semesters

Maximum deadline to submit thesis : December 2026

Rules and conditions of success

- **Mandatory courses: 2 chances maximum**
- UNIGE grading scale is based on 6.00 (0.00 to 6.00)
- Minimal grade to obtain credits is **4.00/6.00**
- Grades are given at ¼ of point for example: 3.75, 4.00, 4.25, 4.50, ...
- You can validate/keep grades between 3.00 and 4.00 for a maximum of 9 credits
- Use the validation form «*Conservation de note*» via Intranet
- Every grade validated/kept is definitively acquired and it is not possible to change your mind

- University taxes CHF 500 have to be paid by the student within deadline
- Change of address need to be amended through your portal my.unige.ch
