





## Postdoctoral researcher position at the Immunity and Small Molecules lab

One postdoctoral position is available at the Immunity and Small Molecules lab at the Centre for research in Molecular Medicine and Chronic Diseases (CiMUS) of the University of Santiago de Compostela (Spain), in the area of **autoantigen discovery in autoimmunity**. Successful candidates will work in the project "Examining the role of self-metabolites as autoantigens in Type 1 Diabetes (Self-MAIT1D)". The position is **fully funded by the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF) until 2028**.

## **Qualifications:**

Candidates must have obtained a **Ph.D. in Immunology** or related fields, with a strong background in T cells, flow cytometry and cell sorting, T cell receptors, primary cell culture, and experience or an interest to learn on **MAIT cells and autoimmunity**, sharing our passion to disentangle autoantigen specificities in Type 1 Diabetes. The selected candidate is expected to **start in mid-May 2024**.

The <u>Immunity and Small Molecules Lab</u>, head by Dr. <u>Iria Gomez-Tourino</u>, is located in the <u>CiMUS</u> research center of the University of Santiago de Compostela, one of the largest universities in Northwest Spain.
