Field Workshop on Magmatic Processes Revealed by the Adamello Batholith, Northern Italy

Goals:

This workshop is designed for doctoral students and other scientists with an active interest in magmatic processes. One day of presentations will be followed by seven days of field observations and discussions about how outcrop relations and the overall structure of a batholithic complex can be converted into petrologic insights.

The course will be organized by Professors Peter Ulmer (ETH-Z) and Jon Blundy (Bristol University, UK) who have been working in the Adamello for many years.

Independent perspectives and expertise will be provided by Professors Robert Weibe (Franklin and Marshall College, Lancaster PA, USA) and Allen Glazner (University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, USA).
