ETHICS AND POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY **Two funded 5-year PhD** positions in Ethics & Political Philosophy (50% each) at the *Université de Fribourg* Responsibilities:

- Writing a doctoral thesis under the supervision of Prof. Ralf Bader;
- Teaching one semester-long proseminar per academic year in German (position 1) / in French (position 2);
- Supporting administrative tasks, research activities and teaching of the chair for ethics and political philosophy;

Requirements:

- Master's degree or equivalent in philosophy;
- Very good knowledge of English and German (position 1) / English and French (position 2);
- PhD project in ethics or political philosophy.
