



Medical Certificate for Accommodations Request (MCAR) at UNIGE

If you have a disability, disorder, or chronic illness, and your health condition significantly affects your ability to take exams under fair conditions compared to other students, you have the right to request accommodations to compensate for your disadvantages. The Special Needs Office at UNIGE evaluates each situation individually to determine if accommodations are justified and can be offered to mitigate the disadvantages a student may face during exams. It is therefore essential that we receive relevant and complete information from your healthcare provider.
