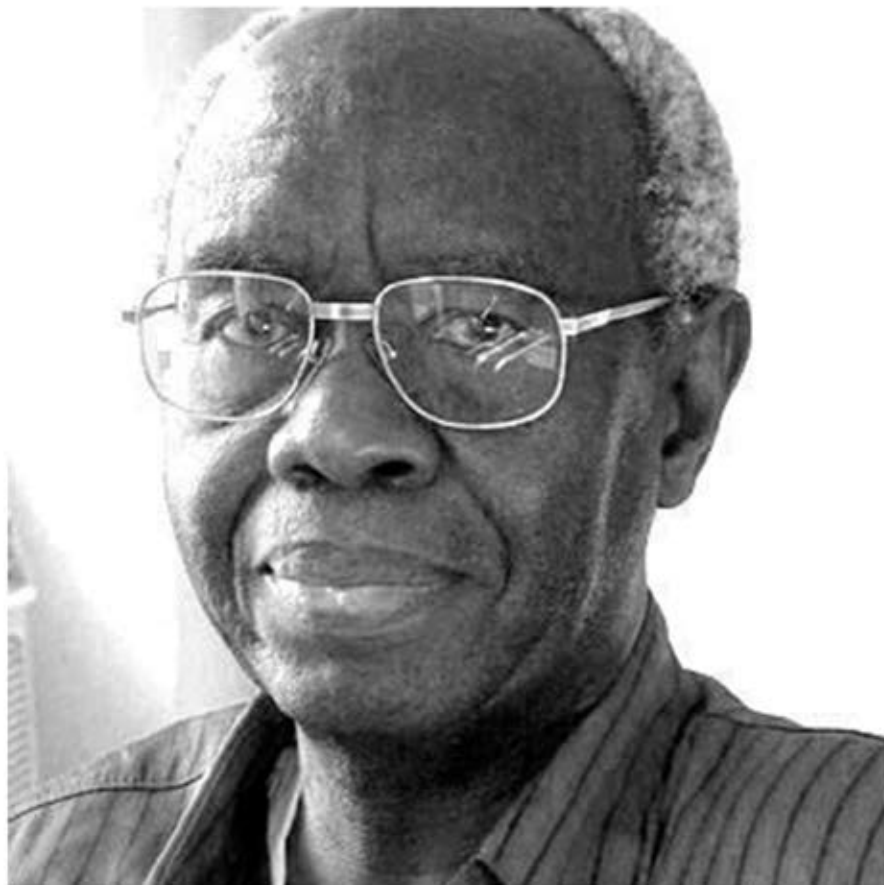


In search for an African theology
